These buckets are also 50 percent deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra room makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads such as broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel and moving large debris piles.

Quick-Tach lift buckets can in several cases substitute the blades and carriage of a lift truck, that may weigh somewhere between 100-700lbs. The Quick-Tach is able to pour materials more or less 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket.
